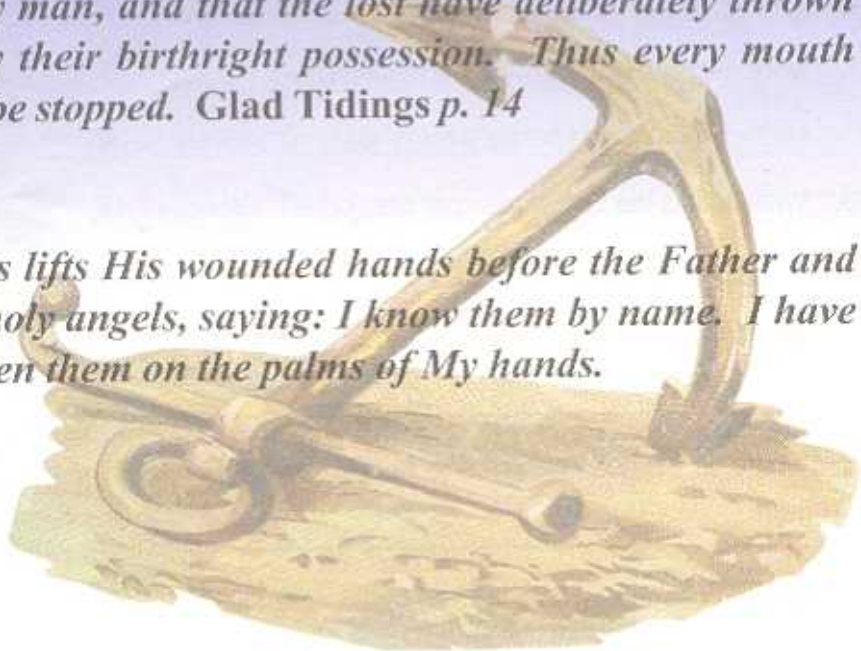


Anchor of Hope
